"Kitten season." Have you heard that term before? If you're a friend of Harbor Humane Society's, or a supporter of the movement to save all animals from unnecessary and senseless euthanasia and adopt them into loving, forever homes, you're probably more familiar than you want to be with kitten season. Those are the times during the year when unsterilized cats are reproducing at record rates and, sadly, many die in shelters simply because there are not enough homes for all of them. In 2014 alone, Harbor Humane Society cared for 717 kittens, out of the 2,228 cats and dogs that came through our doors looking for their second chance at life and love.





You've undoubtedly heard Harbor Humane Society's pleas before: to spay and neuter your cats – your dogs, all your companion animals – and help put an end to pet overpopulation. It's one of our most important mantras. It is estimated there are 70 million stray dogs and cats in the United States due to overpopulation. We have already done our part in the local community by providing FREE spay/neuters for cats and dogs in a mobile home community, thanks to a \$22,500 grant from the Kenneth A. Scott Charitable Trust. It is up to you to help us do MORE for the animals by donating to Harbor Humane Society!
