### **No-kill since January 2015**

A no-kill shelter is defined as an animal shelter that does not kill healthy or treatable animals even when the shelter is full, reserving euthanasia for terminally ill animals or those considered dangerous to public safety. We, at Harbor Humane Society, are proud to be a member of the elite no-kill movement!

Our journey towards no-kill status began in November 2013, when we started a 14 month trial period. Our efforts were successful with increased adoptions, transfers, and return to owner/guardians, not having a time or space limit for animals in our care. Outcome is not the only important factor is reaching no-kill status, consulting individuals to reduce intake is also a big contributor. Our staff and volunteers took on the initiative to educate themselves on how to reduce the number of animals surrendered to our care and offer resources so families do not

have to be split up.

Since we do not euthanize for space or time, some may think that we would be overflowing with animals. That is not the case. We are constantly moving animals in to their new adoptive homes, by frequently offering reduced fee adoptions!

With the added responsility of a no-kill status, comes the added need for increase in donations. Many animals come through our door with an injury or treatable illness, such as, but not limited to: broken bones, upper respiratory infections, heartworm, or even mange. We treat these animals so they can find their second chance at life and love, as they deserve. Some treatments may only cost a couple of dollars, but others may cost hundreds of dollars, and we need your help.



Harbor Humane Society has stepped up in West Michigan as a leader in the no-kill movement, and we invite you to join us. Be an advocate for the animals, not only those pictured, but the nearly 3,000 that come through our doors each year. There are many ways for you to join our life-saving mission.

These sweet faces would not be receiving extra ear scratches, belly rubs, cuddle buddies, or even the feeling of love if we didn't become no-kill. Many animals are scared when they first come through our doors and act inappropriately due to fears. We give them time to adjust and trust people, and sure enough, they come around. Some of these animals had medical conditions that many shelters would deem them "unadoptable". We took the extra time and energy to treat their manageable, non-contagious condition because we knew they would make great companions. Some of these animals were seniors. We took care of their medical needs and assured their comfortable living. *All of these animals were placed in to loving homes because they were given a chance.* 

#### 2015 Updates!

We received a generous grant from an anonymous foundation to renovate our annex and turn it in to a tiered isolation area with a new HVAC system. This allows us to keep our cats healthier, above shelter standards!
