## Adopting a kennel is easy!



Small dog, puppy and cat kennels are just \$25 per month



Large dog kennels are just \$50 per month



The amount can be deducted from your checking account or charged to your credit card automatically



It costs approximately \$20 per day to care for each animal. Kennel sponsorship provide a small portion per month but it is so important! It is support that they can count on every month throughout the next year.

To say THANK YOU, we'll place an engraved plaque on your kennel acknowledging your kindness to our over 30,000 visitors annually. The plaque can be engraved to honor or remember a loved one or beloved pet who has touched your life. At year's end, you can retrieve your plaque as a momento which can grace your Christmas tree.
