

BABIES NEED SPECIAL CARE!












It's puppy and kitten season at Harbor Humane Society. More arrive daily. Your IMMEDIATE help is needed!

Jeffrey and Theodore are 8 week old beagles, left to fend for themselves. A Good Samaritan found them and brought them to our shelter. When they arrived, they were so sick we didn't think they could possibly survive. Testing showed that both puppies were infected with coccidian, a dangerous parasite. However, we didn't give up on these precious babies! Our medical team immediately began a rigorous treatment. The puppies are responding to the medications which your support provides. We are happy to report that while both puppies are still ill, they are improving steadily with each passing day. We now believe that these dogs have a future and look forward to finding them their forever home.
