\*With the exception of CRT (tube) TV's and monitors and items with refrigerant, such as mini-fridges, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.

Tube TV's and monitors have a recycling fee of \$7-\$50 depending on screen size. For items with refrigerant, we charge a flat \$15 recovery fee.
