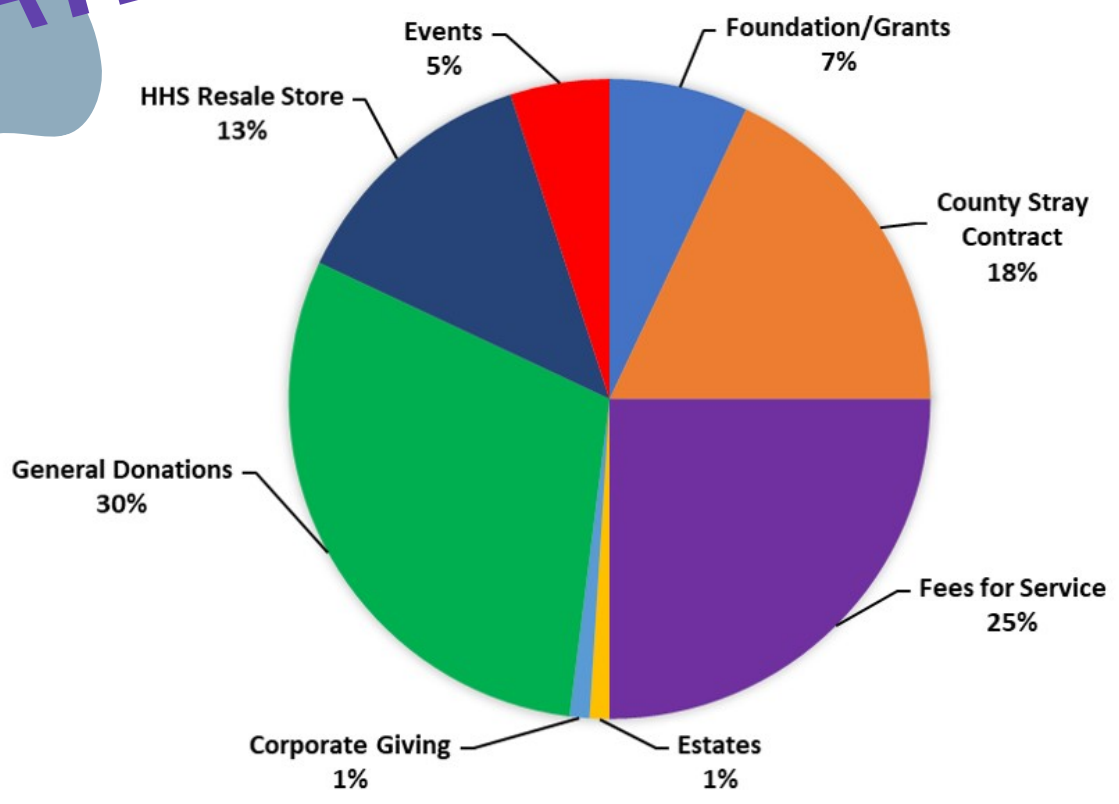


* Animals are transferred in from overcrowded shelters in Michigan and other states as time and space permits us to help.

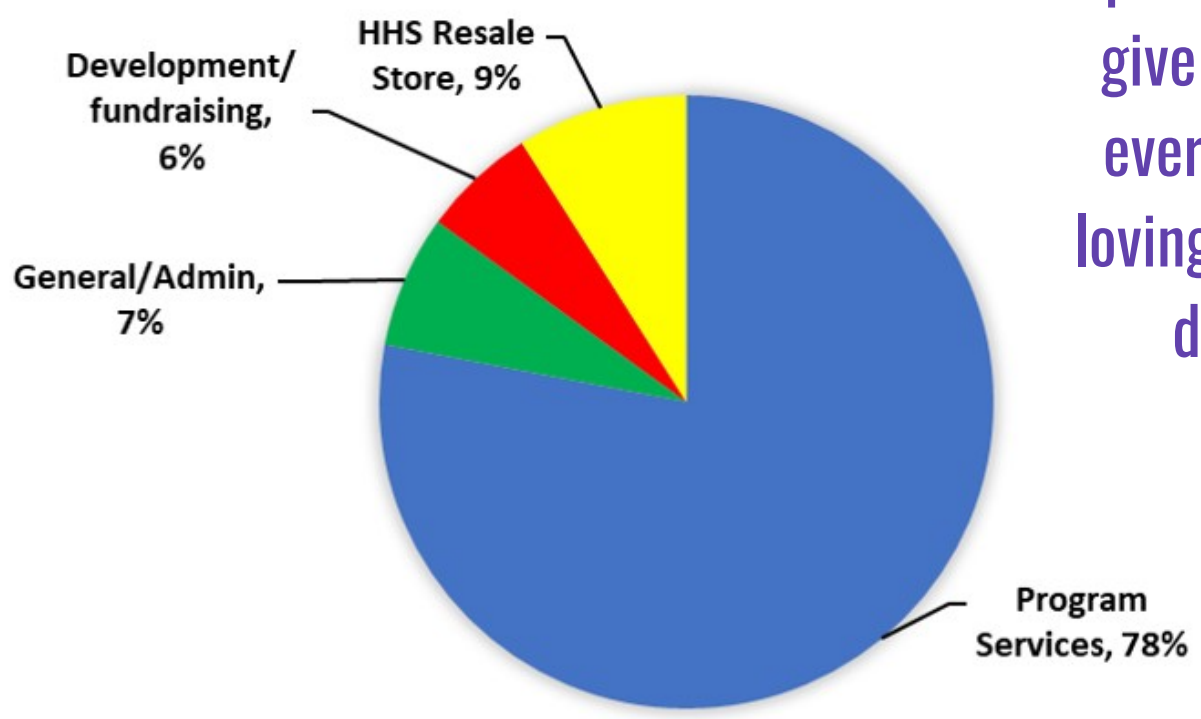
** Animals euthanized were not behaviorally sound or medically suffering. Animals who died include puppies and kittens who were neonatals and despite our best efforts were not able to save.

HHS spends \$30 per day, per animal to give each and every one the loving care they deserve.

Our vet staff completed **3,084** spay and neuter surgeries for dogs and cats!

11% of the surgeries were for members of the public who otherwise could not afford the procedure.

30% were for other adoption agencies.



Volunteers gave **5,879** hours of service!

Our Low Income Vaccine Clinic served **144** dogs and **62** cats!
